Tax Information on Charitable Gifts

For annual donations in excess of \$200, you will receive a combined tax credit of 40.16 cents for every dollar donated. This illustration uses a combined federal and provincial income tax credit of 21.05% on the first \$200 and 40.16% on gifts over \$200.
